It's a better way to go to school three days school one day Tafe one day work. They get paid for their jobs. There's no risk to their employer the employer pays no salaries. We pay that really the only thing the employer does is give the student their time the student gets to look at that employee for two years the boss gets to look at the kid for two years at the end of it. Please kids are all getting jobs and they leave school with those employers. That's a pretty impressive cute. Right? It's a Grassroots organization with strong relationships. It's really genuinely connected to the community. This isn't a nine-to-five program.

This is a 24/7 everyday of the Year commitment that we have to our communities around Australia. I would not think I'd be here doing what I'm doing having a stable routine managing to get out of that bad cycle that everyone's going up and so it's amazing to have the opportunity to be able to change my life and impact others as well.
